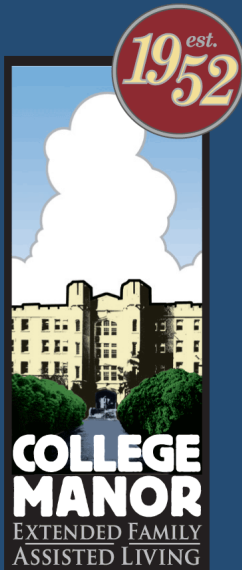

The Caregiver's Support Group will meet on Tuesday, February 19th at 7 p.m. on the sunporch

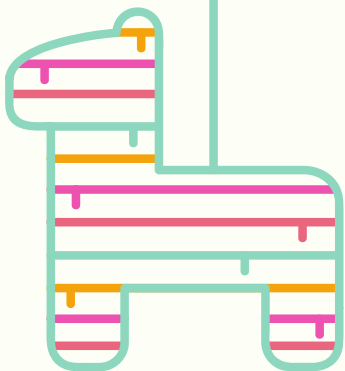
