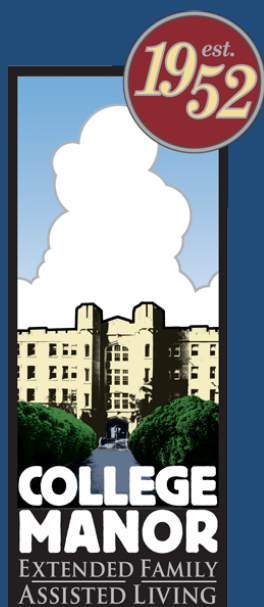


NOVEMBER NEWSLETTER
